



Important Notice

City leaders would like to make you aware of some fee increases that took effect on July 1. These fees have not increased in more than a decade and are based on operational needs within our community. The new rates are consistent with neighboring communities and the revenue anticipated will pay for the actual expense the city incurs in providing these services. If any of these fees apply to you, you will notice them on your *next* utility bill.
