RE: GREEN MEADOWS WEST CENTRAL CHANNEL STABILIZATION PROJECT

The purpose of this letter is to provide you an update and information on the Green Meadows West Central Channel Stabilization Project. This drainage channel is located on outlots owned by the Green Meadows West Homeowners Association, and runs between Hadfield Circle and Heather Bow west of Foxboro Road and Heather Bow and Tiburon Circle east of Foxboro Road. The purpose of the project would be to correct erosion and to stabilize the stream banks from the outlet of the storm sewer project completed in 2010 easterly to Beaver Creek. To that end, the City of Johnston has recently hired HR Green as the design engineer for the project. Kyle Riley, P.E., CFM, will be the project manager and lead engineer on the project. The engineering and construction of any improvements will be funded by the City's Storm water Utility Fund.

The first step in the engineering process is for a tree and topography survey to be completed of the entire area, and to conduct soil borings in various locations throughout the project area. The information collected will be used to determine the full extent of the improvements necessary throughout the drainage channel. This work is scheduled to begin around October, 24, 2016 and last approximately 8 weeks. Please be aware during this time, surveyors will be walking through the corridor collecting information with GPS equipment and soil borings will be collected using both hand and truck mounted augers.

Upon completion of the survey work and prior to the design of any improvements, the City will host a public informational meeting for all interested parties to review the survey information and provide input on the existing conditions and possible improvements. The City will work with the Green Meadows West Homeowners Association to schedule this meeting at a convenient time and location and notice will be mailed in advance. Follow-up meetings will also be scheduled upon completion of design and as necessary throughout the design/construction process.

The City of Johnston, the Green Meadows West Homeowners Association and HR Green share the goal of making every effort to keep you informed on this upcoming project.
